God's Garden

I somehow found a little time to do some necessary repotting and trimming for my indoor plants. As I worked, God reminded how much tending He has to do with me.

- ◆ I sometimes need pruning—My plants work extra hard to push adequate nourishment to dying branches in the hopes of keeping them alive and vibrant. Trouble is, once the dying process starts, there is little that can be done to reverse the process and the extra effort made in the attempt to revive something also results in the denial of needed nutriments to the living parts of the plant. The solution is to cut off the dead or dying parts so that all the plant's energy is devoted to the living parts that remain. I, too, frequently try to hold on to thoughts or behaviors or stuff that no longer serve a useful purpose.
- My roots start showing—When my plants get too big for their pots, I have to repot them. I'm not a fan of this particular part of indoor horticulture because I inevitably get potting soil all over everything. It IS messy, and dirty, and sometimes can require ingenious maneuvers to get the appropriate amount of soil in and around the plant so that it has space to grow, but in the end, both the plant and I are pleased with the result. Exposed human roots are God's way of suggesting that maybe it's time to move on from a place, an attitude, or a behavior and settling somewhere that is more conducive to your development and relationship with God.
- I stretch in odd ways because I'm not getting enough sun. You've probably already guessed that I, too, need more Son in my life. I'm grateful that God consistently reminds me of this daily requirement for Christian growth.

And I haven't mentioned the watering, feeding, cleaning, etc. that happens all the time!

We ARE God's garden and He tends us with love, grace, mercy and forgiveness. Under His care, we thrive.


If you want to see Lee's performance, the theatre is located at 1704 Brian Lane Way and performances are scheduled for:
